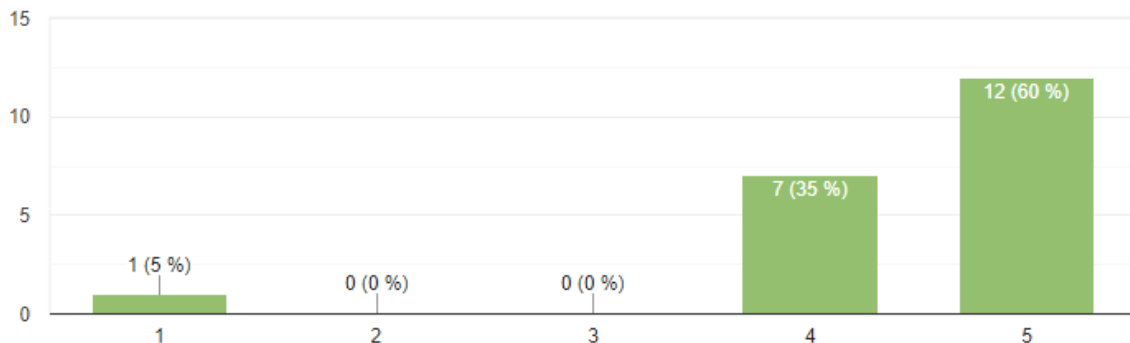

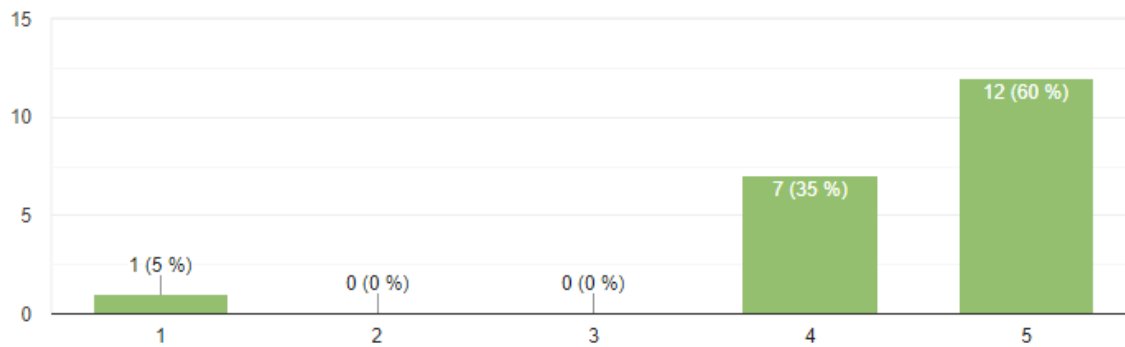

How do you appreciate the speakers' intervention?

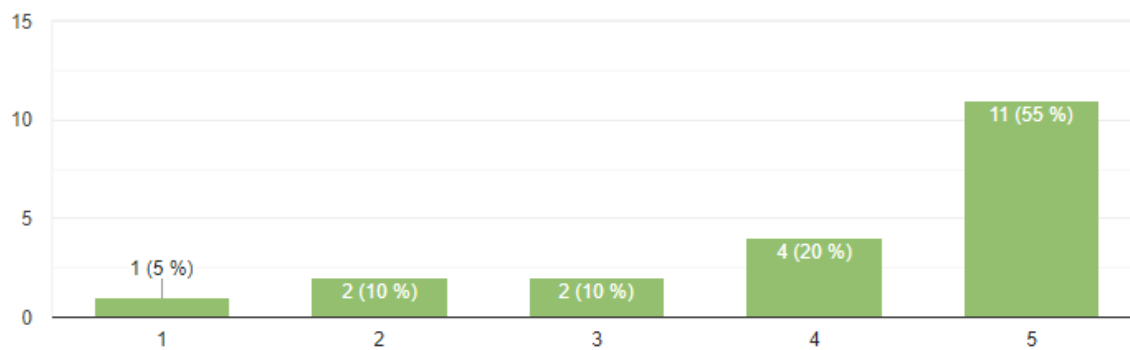

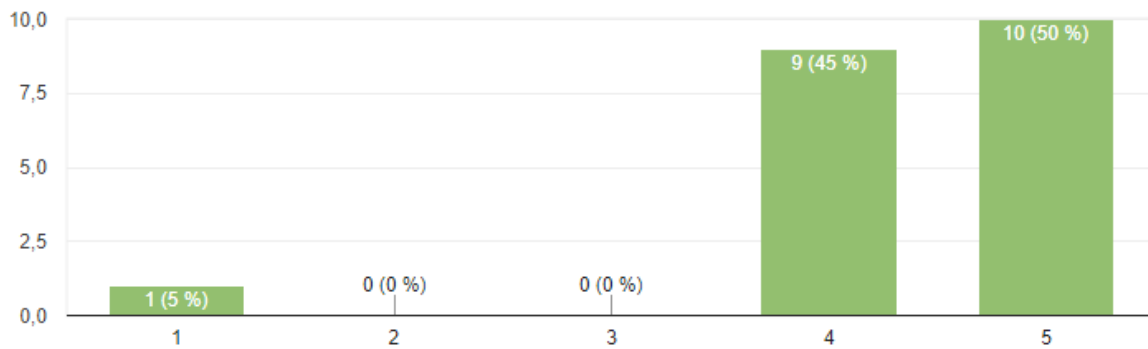
How do you appreciate the time frame of this webinar?
